- The Children's Hospital of Colorado
 NES Clinic is a multidisciplinary clinic
 that treats children and teens, ages 18
 and below, who have been diagnosed
 with Non-Epileptic Seizures (NES).
- The clinic is a <u>one-time consultation</u>
 <u>clinic</u> that occurs virtually only on
 Monday afternoons 2x per month.
- At the clinic, the patient will see a pediatric epileptologist, neurologist, and psychiatrist, along with a social worker.
- We will help you develop an action plan, connect you to an outside therapist, and provide education about the NES diagnosis.

Scheduling

- Patients must be established with outpatient neurologic care at CHCO prior to being seen.
- After establishing care with a CHCO neurologist, the neurologist will determine if a referral should be made to our NES clinic and recommend an Epilepsy Monitoring Unit (EMU) visit, as appropriate.
