<p>Public Library</p>	<p>- All open branch libraries have computers available inside to use with a free Denver Library card. Free Wifi access is available outside all Denver Public Library buildings 24/7. - You can now borrow Chromebooks and internet hotspots to use at home for up to 3 months from the Denver Public Library (DPL). Anyone with a full privilege, permanent DPL library card in good standing can borrow these items for free. You can place a request for either a Chromebook, a wireless hotspot, or both together via the library’s online catalog or by calling 720-865-1111. They can be picked up at any open library location via walk-in or curbside pickup and return is available at all DPL locations. <p>Comcast Internet Service (Discounted)</p>	<p>-Affordable, discounted home Internet service for those who qualify. If you qualify for the Affordable Connectivity Program, service will be completely free. Apply online or call (855) 846-8376.</p>

<p>Part of Affordable Connectivity Program through PCs for People</p>	<p>- To be eligible, a household needs to be 200% or below the federal poverty level or be currently enrolled in an income-based government assistance program. Examples of programs that are eligible include: food support (SNAP), financial assistance (TANF), free or reduced lunch at school, Section 8 Housing, and SSI. Customers must show a photo ID and proof of eligibility. Customers who subscribe to PCs for People and enroll in ACP will effectively get service for free after the government discount is applied.</p>	<p>https://www.pcsforpeople.org/affordable-connectivity-program/</p>
<p>EveryoneOnOffer</p>	<p>-The Affordable Connectivity Program is a Federal Communications Commission (FCC) program that provides a temporary \$30 subsidy on monthly broadband (internet service) bills for qualifying low-income households.</p> <p>-Enter Zip code for low-cost internet service and computers in your area.</p>	<p>https://www.everyoneon.org/find-offers</p> <p>(if you enter the zip-code where you live, and select criteria, it will populate free and low-cost internet and computers near you).</p>
